

A Message From Habitat for Humanity Re: ReStore Operations

Dear Habitat for Humanity Supporter,

I am writing to provide an update about the measures Habitat for Humanity of Mesa County is taking to protect our staff, volunteers and the people we serve during the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic.

These measures are based on guidance from Habitat for Humanity International and local, state and national public health authorities. We are continually monitoring the situation and our approach may change as new guidance is provided.

Given the current circumstances and to safeguard our volunteers, donors and staff, as of 5:00 p.m. March 20, 2020, we will temporarily close our ReStore and affiliate offices to the public. We will send out additional updates as conditions change. Our affiliate staff will remain available by email and/or by phone in order to continue assisting homeowner partners.
