

## Accident Medical Expense Benefit

- ◆ Up to \$50,000 for in- & out-patient hospital, Ambulatory Medical Center & Emergency Room, physician visits & surgery, diagnostic tests, nursing services, and ambulance charges
- ◆ Excess—pays benefits after any other health care plans have paid benefits
- ◆ Dental Coverage—\$1,000 maximum benefit, up to \$300 per tooth
- ◆ A \$250 deductible applies to this benefit



### Accidental Death and Dismemberment Benefit

- \$50,000—Loss of Life
- \$50,000—Loss of any combination of two: hands, feet, eyesight, speech, and hearing
- \$25,000—Total paralysis of upper and lower limbs, both lower limbs, or upper and lower limbs on one side of the body
- \$25,000—Loss of one hand, one foot, sight in one eye, speech, or hearing
- \$12,500—Loss of thumb and index finger of same hand
- \$10,000—Loss of life due to heart failure

## Personal Liability Insurance

All registered volunteers are covered by RSVP's liability insurance at a limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

This policy provides protection for a bodily injury or a property damage liability claim arising out of the performance of registered volunteers' duties.

This insurance does not duplicate benefits payable under Medicare or any other valid and collectible

## Excess Automobile Liability Insurance

This coverage protects the registered volunteer driver for bodily injury or property damage caused to any third party, including while driving directly between a registered volunteer driver's residence and workstation.

The combined single limit, as respects bodily injury and property damage of a third party, is \$1,000,000 each accident.

This gives you additional automobile liability insurance while you are volunteering and helping others.



**You must have minimum automobile liability insurance as required by Colorado Law and give RSVP the name of your car insurer.**

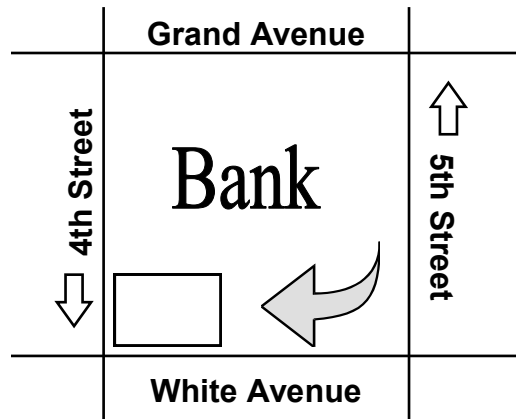
